

## Pinecone Post: A Shared Moment from the Trail

## A Chapel in the Woods activity from Papa and Baylor Go Fishing

Papa reminded Baylor that sometimes the best adventures aren't about what we catch—but who we share them with.

This craft helps you think of someone special, then share something kind to brighten their day—just like Baylor did with Cheddar.

## Materials Needed:

- A real pinecone
- Small piece of paper (for the scroll)
- Crayon, pencil, or pen
- String, yarn, or ribbon
- Pinecone Post Tag

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Think of someone special—someone who made you smile, helped you, or showed kindness.
- 2. Write or draw something kind about them on your paper. It could be a word of encouragement, a favorite memory, a Bible verse, or a reason you're glad they're in your life.
- 3. Roll or fold the paper into a tiny scroll.
- 4. Tuck it gently inside your pinecone. If the scales are too tight, you can tie it with string.
- 5. Attach the Pinecone Post Tag using string or ribbon to tie it around the pinecone. This lets the person know there's something kind tucked inside.
- 6. Place your Pinecone Post in a cozy nook or on a trail where someone might discover it.
